Payment of fees: Invoices will be issued in the last month of the preceding term via email and must be paid by the due date. Please ensure your email address is current.

Deposit: Parents/guardians are required to pay the fee deposit on offer of a place. This payment is retained and credited to term 4 fees. Payment is required by the due date to secure the child's place in the three-year-old kindergarten program.

Refundable Maintenance levy: A \$150 Maintenance levy (per child) is charged as part of the Term 1 fees. This is refunded in Term 4 upon participation at a 3-hour kindergarten working bee, of which 4 are scheduled per year.

Fundraising levy: The Fundraising levy covers the costs for Kinder social activities and events including Mothers' and Fathers' Day Tea parties, Welcome Morning Tea, Open Day activities. These events are available to all families in the Kinder with most families reporting a true sense of connection and belonging that these events generate. It is vital that all families contribute to this levy to ensure the Kinder is able to continue to run these events.

Early start kindergarten fee subsidy: Families who are eligible for the Early Start Kindergarten fee subsidy (refer to Fees Policy for Families) will pay concession fee payments.

Children turning three during the year: Full payment from the first day of term 1 is required if a place is to be reserved for a child in the three-year-old kindergarten program, however children can only commence the program when they have turned three. Please Note: children who have not yet turned three at the commencement of the kinder year are welcome and encouraged to attend the first day scheduled as orientation day.

Late collection charge: The Committee of Management reserves the right to implement a late collection charge when parents/guardians are frequently late in collecting a child (refer to Fees Policy for Families).
